

Spook-o-Ree Contest Rules



Youth Costume Contest!

Bring your child's Halloween costume to camp and enter in the contest!
Creative, homemade costumes are great!

How it works:

1. Within your pack on Saturday afternoon vote for the best youth costume. Each pack can choose 1 Cub Scout and 1 Sibling.
2. Send your Pack winners in costume to the Saturday night campfire for the camp-wide costume contest.

Pumpkin Design Contest!

Please bring your own pumpkin decorating materials to camp with you: paints, markers, carving knives, sparkles, etc.

Every youth, 5 years or older, will receive a pumpkin. You will have time scheduled during the Saturday activities for Scouts & siblings to decorate their pumpkins in your campsite.

We can't wait to see all the wonderful designs they make!

1. Each Pack will judge and choose one winner each for the best Cub Scout Carved Pumpkin, Cub Scout Decorated Pumpkin, and Sibling Decorated Pumpkin on Saturday within your campsites.
2. Bring the three winning pumpkins to the campfire Saturday evening to be judged for the campwide pumpkin contest.

A few notes:

- Cub Scouts must decorate their own pumpkins.

- Tiger and Wolf Cub Scouts are not to use knives to carve pumpkins. Only Scouts with their Whittling Chip or Pumpkin Carving Card (given at leader's meeting) are allowed to use knives of any kind.

- The winning pumpkins brought to the Saturday campfire must be **clearly marked** on the bottom with the youth's name, pack number and whether it is a Cub or Sibling.

Adult Costume Contest!

Spend your assigned pack time to let your Cub Scouts decorate you!

Each pack can enter one adult dressed up in "camp materials!"

What to do:

1. In order to enter the adult costume contest the costume must be created using items native to the area or brought with you to Spookoree. **No store bought costumes.**
2. Use your imagination to create a fun costume, be sure to name your costume and wear it to the campfire!
