Flint River Council - Fayette District "Kick the COVID" Camporee 24-26 March 2023 (Friday thru Sunday afternoon)

Gerald I Lawhorn Scouting Base

Scout troops from Flint River Council, Fayette District will participate in the district SPRING CAMPOREE at the Gerald I Lawhorn Scouting Base – Camp Thunder 24-26 March 2023. The Saturday program activity will consist of rifle and shotgun range operations, a "Corn Hole" Challenge, and different outdoor cooking technique demonstrations, menus, food tasting, and cooking activity skills. The Saturday cooking program will conclude with all participating troops providing select Dutch Oven or One Pot menus for a "DISTRICT" wide "TOP CHEF" judging contest and pot luck dinner.



Troops will camp overnight at Camp Thunder using FRC tents in assigned camp sites. Plan to depart Camp Thunder after 1200pm on Sunday, 26 March.

- ❖ <u>24 March Friday</u> arrive at Camp Thunder, set up individual camp sites and conduct individual troop activities. <u>Troops prepare evening meal in their</u> campsite.
- ❖ <u>25 March Saturday</u> Troops prepare breakfast in campsite. CAMPOREE activities include cooking demonstrations, Corn Hole competition, and Rifle and Shotgun Range operations from 10:00am-12:00pm and 1:00-3:00pm. The evening meal at 6:00pm (location TBD) will be a consolidated potluck combining all participating cook team menus with hamburgers and hotdogs.

Awards for three menu categories (desert, breakfast menu and dinner meal) will be presented after the evening meal. Plan to participate in an evening campfire.

26 March - Sunday Troop prepared b<u>reakfast in your campsite</u> followed by District Vespers Service, tear down, pack up and departure.

Coordinating Instructions:

- Complete and provide a Troop registration (List Scouts and Adults) NLT 11 March 2023. This Registration should be up by the end of next week.
- Each troop should plan to prepare to enter a minimum of 2 Menu categories for judging at the evening
 - POT LUCK. Each Dutch Oven or One Pot menu should feed 10 scouts or leaders. At least one should be a dinner entrée and the second one may be a desert.
- Fayette District leadership will provide Hamburgers, hotdogs, and condiments, drinks, & paper products for the potluck.
- Troops may plan individual activities (Friday, Saturday, Sunday) as desired.
- Cost for the CAMPOREE outing is \$15.00/person for camping, ammunition, Burgers and Dogs as well as TOP CHEF AWARDS. PLEASE provide Payment with registration.
- Campsite area will be assigned at check in.
- Provide our Troop Chaplain Aide to assist in the Sunday morning Worship /Vespers Service FRAA.
- Clear your campsite, remove all trash and equipment and check out at the CAMPOREE PAVILLION prior to departure on Sunday, 26 March.
