- 3. The camping requirements that apply for youth candidates apply to adult candidates and must have been fuffiled within the most recent two years prior to recommendation for membership. The requirement, which is a minimum of fifteen days and nights of camping, which must include six days and five nights of resident camping approved and under the auspices and standards of the Boy Scouts of America, was fulfiled as follows:
