**Congratulations! You have been elected by your unit to become a member of the Order of the Arrow, Scouting's National Honor Society. This letter is designed to answer many of the questions you may have, and to assist you in completing process to join the OA!**

At the Call Out, you received a "Candidate's Arrow". It signifies that you are now a Candidate for the Order, and that you will complete your induction into the Order of the Arrow in order to become an Arrowman. Please wear this Arrow with pride until and throughout your Ordeal. If you did not receive an Arrow yet, don't worry: You'll receive one at your induction weekend.

The Ordeal induction weekend is an experience designed to help you gain a deeper understanding of the Scout Oath and Law, and to learn the value of unselfish service to others.

**The Fall Ordeal weekend will begin promptly at 8 p.m., Friday, March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021, and will end at 10:00 a.m., Sunday, March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Please plan accordingly. If our schedule changes due to COVID-19 restrictions, we will notify you promptly.**

Please arrive at Camp Thunder at Howard Lodge **no later 7:00 p.m. on Friday evening for check-in. You must bring a current BSA medical form with you to this event. Due to Covid-19 restrictions, you must wear a mask at all times at this event, and temperature checks will be administered upon arrival.**

No meals will be served Friday, so please eat dinner before you arrive.

You should **wear "work clothes"** and your **Candidate's Arrow** to camp. Boots are strongly encouraged. **DO NOT** wear your scout uniform. You will need the following equipment for Friday night: **sleeping bag, ground cloth, canteen, pocketknife, bug repellent and a poncho.**

**Packed separately**, you should work gloves, tools, your toilet articles, a towel, your complete Class "A" Scout Uniform for the induction ceremony, and any other necessary items. Our service projects will include outdoor conservation work, so please bring work gloves.

**Pre-Registration is required for this event, so please register online at [www.flintrivercouncil.org](http://www.flintrivercouncil.org) at the link shown in this email.**

The cost of the ordeal is \$60.00 which includes all meals on Saturday (breakfast, lunch and dinner) plus breakfast on Sunday, an Order of the Arrow Handbook, a current Lodge flap, an Ordeal sash and dues for the 2020 and 2021. We have many other items for sale in our trading post, including lodge t-shirts, extra lodge flaps, and various other memorabilia, so please plan to bring a little extra money.

The Ceremony is for candidates and members only. Nonmembers must have prior approval (before the start of the Ordeal) from the Lodge Advisor to attend.

For those unable to attend our induction at this year’s Fall Ordeal, your next opportunity to become a member of Scouting’s National Honor Society will be on May 14-16, 2021.
