Reservation of facilities requires a 25% reservation deposit. This facility deposit is refundable unless your reservation is canceled less than 10 business days prior to your event. All deposits for program activities are non-refundable.

Refundable deposit totaling 50% of program-related fees is due 30 days prior to your event.

Payment in full is due upon arrival to the Lawhorn Scouting Base.



## Sleeping Facilities

### Signature Campsites

The hallmark of Lawhorn Scouting Base, our campsites each feature canvas tents on wooden platforms, built-in bunks with mattresses, activity pavilions, and restrooms with showers. Campsites are available in 2 or 4 person tents.

### Cabins

The camp features several private cabins that sleep up to 10 people. All cabins feature full bathrooms and some are equipped with kitchenettes and living areas.

Located on Pine Mountain 27 miles southeast of Griffin, Georgia, our property is adjacent to the Flint River which provides over 75 miles of pristine canoeing experience and the best spot in the world for fishing of Shoal Bass.

Each summer, over 1,500 youth embark on unique adventures on Pine Mountain and the Flint River, including mountain boarding, rock climbing, and canoeing. Each winter we provide the best in wilderness adventure and cold weather camping.

During the fall, spring, and winter, our facility is available for corporate groups and organizations. If you would like to have a rustic conference or gathering in this beautiful wilderness setting, please consider the Lawhorn Scouting Base.

### Meeting Facilities

Our indoor facilities come equipped with folding tables, plastic chairs, white board, and projection screen. All facilities are heated for winter use:

- Historic Howard Lodge: Features stone fireplace and seating for 60 (30 with tables).
- Camp Thunder Dining Hall: Seats 400.
- Flint River Adventure Area Dining Hall: Seats 100.
- River Experience Center: Features meeting room for 15 and smaller room for 5.

We also have outdoor facilities that include the Grand Pavilion, with seating for 200 and an outdoor fire ring.

### Service Facilities

Full service kitchens are available in both dining halls that include deep fat fryers, steamers, warming ovens, convection ovens, steam table, salad bar, walk-in freezer and cooler, and Hobart dish washer.
