Boy Scout-Safe Scout Challenge Requirements

- 1. All leaders have current Youth Protection Training*
- 2. At least on adult on every outing has current Weather Awareness Training*
- 3. When activities are in or on the water, leaders have current Safe Swim Defense* and/or Safety Afloat* training, whichever is appropriate for the activity.
- 4. On hiking activities, the accompanying adults have current Trek Safely Training*
- 5. Adults providing transportation have signed a Save Drive Pledge.
- 6. A well-stocked Unit First Aid Kit is taken on all outings.
- 7. At lease on leader on all outings has a cell phone or radio that has functional service in the area where any outing will take place.
- 8. At least 50% of Scout have earned the First Aid Merit Badge.
- 9. All Scout know their full name, address and phone number and how to summon help in case of an emergency.
- 10. Scout assist in performing an annual safety review of the place in which they meet, including areas where exits are located and what they should do in case of fire.
- 11. Leaders have access to the current Guide to Safe Scouting and review proper safety guidelines for activities the Troop will engage in.
