## **Venture Scout Safe Requirements**

- 1. All leaders have current Youth Protection Training\*
- 2. All Advisors and at least 75% of youth have current Weather Awareness Training\*, Safe Swim Defense Training\*, Safety Afloat Training\* and Trek Safely Training\*
- 3. Leaders have access to the current <u>Guide to Safe Scouting</u> and review proper safety guidelines for activities the Crew will engage in.
- 4. At least one leader on all outings has a cell phone or radio with functional service in the area where any outing will take place.
- 5. A well-stocked Unit First Aid Kit is taken on all outings.
- 6. All drives have signed a Safe Drive Pledge.
- 7. At least 75% of all Crew members have completed a standard first aid course plus the American Red Cross "When Help is Delayed" module or equivalent course.
- 8. All member have a personal first aid kit that they take with them on all outings.
- 9. Prior to all high adventure outings, proper skill training and practice is conducted for all participants.
- 10. For all water activities, at least two members will have current BSA Lifeguard certification.
- 11. The Crew will conduct an annual safety review of the place where they meet, including where exits are located and what they should do in case of fire.
