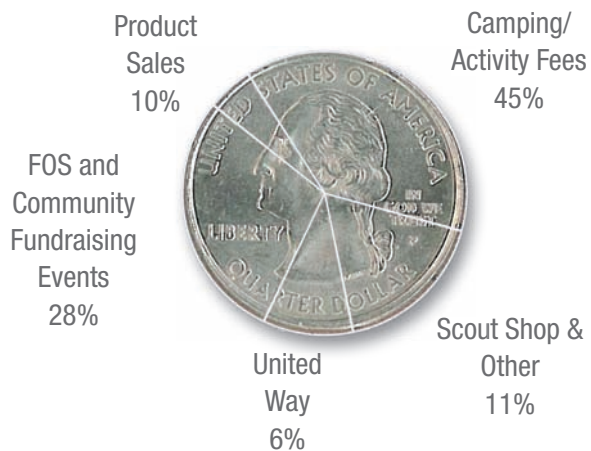


Scouting's Bottom Line:
