



Suggested items to bring to camp:

- Sleeping bag/Sheets/Blankets (Platform tents – twin size beds/ Cabins – Full size beds)
- Clothes to sleep in
- Pillow
- Flashlight
- Personal items (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, other toiletries)
- Towel & Shower shoes
- Extra clothes/shoes/socks
- Rain Gear
- Insect Repellent
- Sunscreen
- Water bottle
- Camp Chair
- Food/drink/snacks (Trading post will be open.)
- Cooking equipment
- Trash bags
- Class A Uniform

The following rules are enforced at the Lawhorn Scouting Base:

1. NO pets or other animals are allowed on BSA property. (Registered service animals are permitted.)
2. NO alcoholic beverages or illicit substances are permitted on camp premises.
3. NO fires or other heat sources are allowed in tents, Adirondacks, cabins or any other camp structure.
4. All vehicles must be parked in one of the camp designated parking lots.
5. NO one may ride in the back of a truck or trailer; seat belts must be worn by everyone in a moving vehicle.
6. The speed limit at camp is 9 MPH. Pedestrians ALWAYS have the right of way. (When driving through camp always be aware of your surroundings.)
7. Closed-toed shoes must be worn at all times. Sandals may only be worn for showering purposes.
8. Two-deep leadership is required at all times for youth. BSA Youth Protection guidelines must be practiced; leaders AND parents must be trained.
9. Bicycles are not permitted.
10. All fuel for lanterns, stoves, etc. must be handled only by adults. Fuel must be secured and locked away.
11. NO Firearms or ammunition of any kind are allowed at camp.
12. Fireworks are prohibited.
